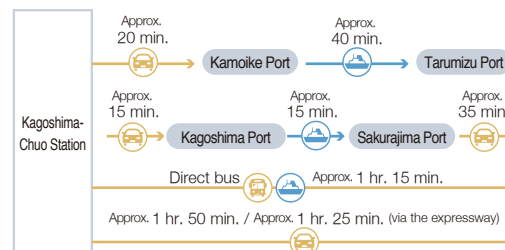

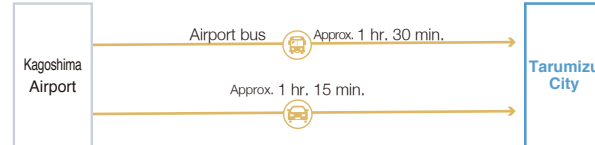

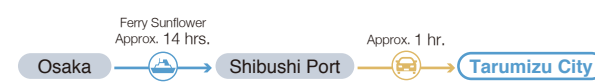
Traveling from Kagoshima-Chuo Station
